Responding to the reading

In John 10:22-30, Jesus speaks about his followers hearing his voice and following him, promising eternal life and safety in his care.

Think for a moment: what are some ways you hear Jesus' voice today?

Jesus' promise that his sheep hear his voice and follow his is comforting. It tells us that being part of his flock means you are never alone; his guidance and protection are always with you.

As you reflect on what these this reading may mean, how can you strive to be attentive to the voice of Jesus, guiding you through the Holy Spirit?

What does it look like for you to be ready to serve, using your gifts to manifest God's kingdom on earth as it is in heaven, as you anticipate the glorious future promised in the Scriptures.

Pray for a moment:

Gracious God, thank you for the vision of a world made new, where every tear is wiped away, and every heart knows your comfort and provision.

Help me to hear your voice clearly and to follow faithfully, serving those around me with the love and compassion you have shown me. Empower me to be an agent of your grace in this world.

Prayers and Prayer Pointers

Monday 12th May

Wednesday 14th May

Friday 16th May

- Draw around the shape of your hand. Write on it the things that you're carrying that feel like burdens. Offer them to God in prayer, remembering that God carries your burdens with you.
